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## <u>Instructions</u>:

• Nothing to eat or drink after midnight the night before your procedure. Small drinks of water are okay. No coffee, soda, juice, chewing gum, etc.

• On the morning of the procedure, you must take your usual medication(s) with only SMALL sips of water. Blood thinner and insulin medications will be discussed in the bold sections below.

• When you arrive at the facility, patients should proceed directly to the main registration check in. The procedure is done on an outpatient basis; HOWEVER, since general anesthesia is involved, you will need to have some to drive you home post-op. Typically, the patient will be discharged home a few hours after the procedure.

• Blood test(s) and EKG may be performed after checking in, and the nurses may insert an IV.

• Results will be given to the patient at their scheduled appointment time, usually 2-3 weeks after the procedure. Some results take up to 6 weeks to be finalized.

# <u>Reminders</u>:

- □ Aspirin/Eliquis/Xarelto- Stop 24 hours prior
- □ Lovenox (Enoxaparin)- Stop 24 hours prior
- □ Plavix (Clopidogrel)- Stop 5-7 prior (if OK'd by prescribing physician)
- □ Coumadin (Warfarin)- Stop 5 days prior
- □ Insulin/ Diabetic Pills- May be altered by physician for 24 hours
- $\Box$  Blood pressure Pills- Must be taken as usual on the day of the procedure
- $\Box$  Water pills (diuretics)- Must <u>skip</u> the day of the procedure
- $\Box$  Antibiotics- Should be taken <u>after</u> procedure is complete
